

Dear Parents,

Thank you for signing up for Minnesota's Future Hockey Camp. There will be one session of Mites the week of (August 1-5) and one session of Squirts August (12-17). Coach Grant Potulny will lead instructor the Mites and Squirts camps. Justin Johnson will work with the goalies and at least two current Gopher players will be with the campers throughout the day.

Here is some important information for the camp:

1. **Drop-off/Pick-up:** The Mites and Squirts will use the locker rooms at Mariucci Arena. Please use the operations entrance on the southwest corner of Mariucci Arena on 4th Street to enter the arena.
2. **All campers must be signed in and out** by a parent daily at the locker rooms of Mariucci Arena. Parents car-pooling may sign more than 1 player in and out. We will have a counselor available by the locker rooms at 9:30AM for signing in and a counselor available after the 3:00pm scrimmage. Please be on time to drop off or pick up your player.
3. **Parking:** Parking is available on the North side of Ridder Arena on 5th Street. Park in Lot#37 or you can use the meters by Ridder Arena on 5th Street.
4. **Locker-room:** The Mites and Squirts will be assigned a locker room at Mariucci Arena. You will be able to leave their equipment in the locker room for the week. You will have to bring your equipment home at the end of each day.
5. **Lunch:** Make sure you bring your own lunch and beverage daily. We will be providing all snacks for the week of the camp.
6. **Blisters:** These are always a problem at camp. Make sure your child's skates still fit and do not break in new skates at camp. Dry socks at all 3 skating sessions will also help prevent blisters.
7. **Skate sharpening:** Is not available.
8. Every camper must have shorts and tennis shoes for off-ice activities.
